# SCHOLAR

In addition to meeting the 24-credit standard high school diploma requirements, a student must attain the following to earn a scholar diploma designation:

- Earn one credit in Algebra 2 or an equally rigorous course;
- Pass the Geometry EOC assessment;
- Earn one credit in Statistics or an equally rigorous mathematics course;
- Pass the Biology 1 EOC assessment;
- Earn one credit in Chemistry or Physics;
- Earn one credit in a course equally rigorous to Chemistry or Physics;
- Pass the U.S. History EOC assessment;
- Earn two credits in the same World Language; and
- Earn at least one credit in an AP, IB, AICE or dual enrollment course.



### MERIT

In addition to meeting the 24-credit standard high school diploma requirements, a student must attain one or more industry certifications from the list established under s. 1003.492, F.S.

## BILITERACY

In addition to meeting the 24-credit standard high school diploma requirements, a student must attain one of the following criteria for eligibility:

#### **Gold Seal of Biliteracy**

Has earned four world language credits in the same world language with a cumulative 3.0 GPA or higher on a 4.0 scale

and

Level 4 or higher on the Grade 10 FSA ELA OR

Has achieved a qualifying score on a world language assessment

- AP Language Exam 4 or higher
- AICE Subject Test A, B, C, D

### **Silver Seal of Biliteracy**

Has earned four world language credits in the same world language with a cumulative 3.0 GPA or higher on a 4.0 scale

- AP Language Exam 3 or higher
- AICE Subject Test A, B, C, D. or E
